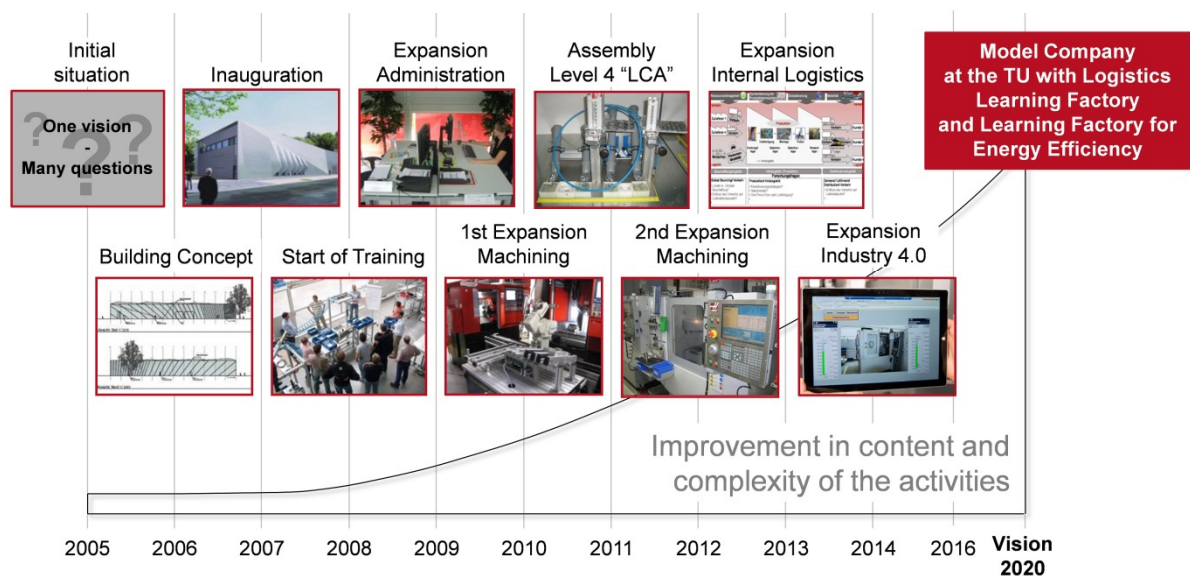
## Stations

For start please enter the public transport station closest to your hotel . Your destination is "Darmstadt Hbf".

For example, the S-Bahn line S3 regularly goes between "Bad Soden" and Darmstadt, and also stops at the fairground and the Frankfurt main station. There is a connection arriving at Darmstadt at 07:55 and one at 8:25 which may be convenient.
